Background:

As per the Presidential Decree No. 44 dated 23rd June 2016 based on Cabinet Resolution no 3 dated 30 April 2016 of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, in order to create safe urban environment and tackle the problems caused by ever increasing population growth in the capital considering the concentrated economic activities and services provision, Dehsabz City Development Authority (DCDA) has been promoted to Capital Region Independent Development Authority (CRIDA) having the authority as Independent Budgetary Unit and Governmental profitable entity within the organizational structure of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan.

The capital region comprises the Kabul city including its all districts, Maidan Shahr City of Maidan Wardak Province, Charikar City and the districts of Bagram and Jabal Siraj of Parwan province, Mahmud Raqi City and Kohistanat district of Kapisa Province, Pul-i-Alam City and Mohammad Agha and Khoshi districts of Logar Province. The total area of the capital region surrounds more than 7735 km².

Capital Region Independent Development Authority (CRIDA), not only develop Kabul New City Master Plans but also pave the ways for the development of Capital Region with broader visions which are briefly narrated as follows:

1. Transforming the Capital Region by turning it into a mega city that is clean, full of greenery, cultured with booming industries and commerce, sports and tourism and ultimately a city with all facilities that are available in any modern city of the world.
2. Building a metropolitan city that is self-reliant and sustainable, a city that has infrastructure and facilities of high standards with healthy physical environment.
3. Building a city that is free of ethnic, linguistic, racial and religious prejudices
4. Promoting urban culture and enhancing the standard of city life through development of the Capital Region.
5. Development of cities (through decentralization for balanced development) within the Capital Region by protecting the originality, historical value and organic linkages with the existing Kabul city to transform the entire capital zone into a symbol of national unity.

CRIDA is currently looking for a **Transportation Planner** to play active role in urban planning division and contribute in managing and preparation of multidisciplinary urban plans and designs for achieving the strategic goals of CRIDA on objective basis.

Reporting Line:

The Transportation Planner will be reporting directly to Urban planning Manager

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Manage and organize the tasks and prepare detailed work plan (Weekly, Monthly and Annual)
- Assist in developing Sustainable and Environmentally friendly transportation strategy for Capital Region
- Develop applicable scenarios of public transportation for the Capital Region in consideration to KMA and KNC master plan's provision
- Develop an applicable TOD based development strategies to major city linkages in the capital region.
- Developing clear and comprehensive reports and presenting options and recommendations on transport systems
- Developing initial design ideas for new or improved transport infrastructure, e.g. junctions, bus stops, terminals and pedestrian facilities;
- Using mathematical and computer simulation models to forecast the effects of road improvements, policy changes and/or public transport schemes;
- Evaluating the benefits and costs of different strategies for developing transportation system;
- Develop guidelines for efficient transportation system for physically challenged and disabled people.
- Conducting travel demand analysis for capacity assessment of road network and proposing road hierarchy for circulation of traffic.
- Consideration of the recommendations of other infrastructure such as sewerage, drainage, water supply, telecommunication
- Assist in preparation of land grading plans for different areas and its consideration in road network plan
- Assessing infrastructure requirements (access, car parking, bus stops, cycle parking, etc) of new developments of transportation system
- Modeling traffic flows using mathematical techniques and specialist computer applications
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor degree in Road and Transportation Planning or Urban Planning with master degree three years of work experience
- Minimum 2 years of experience in the field of transportation network
- Experience in skillful usage of computer and office software packages such as word, Excel, Power Point, Project, Auto CAD Civil 3D, Arc GIS, Trans CAD, VISIM, VISUM, JICA STRADA and other transportation planning software.
- Excellent knowledge of written and spoken English and Afghan national Languages

Experience/Personal skills:

- Ability to conduct travel demand analysis for capacity assessment of roads
- Understand overall transportation modes and models
- Good communication skills, both written and oral
- High levels of creativity, imagination and vision

- Ability to integrate the landscape components such as plantation, retaining walls, waterways, sidewalks, water ponds and other components in detailed plans.
- Ability to conduct economic and environmental justification of the land development
- Willingness to work long hours, under time and budget pressure
- Strong mathematical skills
- A keen eye for the detail of specific tasks, combined with an understanding of how such specifics fit in with the project as a whole
